55. To approve the minutes of the March 2022 Recreation, Amenities and Environment Committee meeting (Appendix A). It was resolved, the minutes were approved and signed as a true record.	Councillors
56. Recreational facilities updates. To discuss and agree any actions (a) Meadow Lane play park update. The clerk reported that the rocking horse has now been replaced. The zip wire and the gates are due to be fixed in the next few days. The meeting agreed to accept a donation from a member of the public of a 'xylophone bench' for the park. Cllr Thorn has been monitoring and fixing equipment in the park and the meeting expressed its thanks to him. (b) Skatepark update. The clerk reported that a cabling duct will be installed across the field to the skatepark to allow CCTV to be installed on the skatepark if required. The muddy mounds on the skatepark will be covered with artificial grass. All work is being paid for using skatepark funding. Graffiti is becoming more of an issue. (c) Playing field update. Cllr Lovelass mentioned a potential 7-year pitch maintenance agreement with the FA. He will provide the clerk with details. (d) Provision of play facilities in Cologne Road. The clerk reported that some tree maintenance is required before discussions about a medium to long term lease for the area behind Cologne Road Community Road can progress. A longer term lease is required before funding for play park equipment can be secured. The clerk will obtain quotes from tree surgeons. Discussions are also in progress regarding a medium to long term lease for Morris Road play park as an alternative.	Clerk/Councillors
