

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BINDON LANE, WOOL

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along BINDON LANE, WOOL from the junction with Highwood to outside Inglewood Farm (in both directions), a distance of approximately 480 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:30 until 15:30 on 12th September 2022 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12th September 2022.

This Notice will provide Openreach with safe access to undertake pole tests.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Holme Lane, B3070, A352, Woolbridge Roundabout, A352, B3070 Station Road, Bindon Lane and vice versa.
