Cllr Wharf gave a verbal update of the contents of his monthly report.</p> <p>d) Wool Parish Neighbourhood Plan update. Cllr Wilson gave a verbal update that the third party continues to progress the Neighbourhood Plan.</p> <p>e) Guest Speaker. Cllr Tony Ferrari to talk about The Dorset Innovation Park (for background reading please see Appendix B pages 99 to 204). Cllr Ferrari talked about the Dorset Innovation Park (DIP) and made the following key points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The combination of military infrastructure and 5G communications makes the DIP a nationally unique offering which is why he believes it will be a success. All the units have been sold and new companies are lined up. • There are around 800 employees currently which is hoped to increase to around 2,000 by 2040. • The jobs created by the DIP will not initially be for residents of the parish but the number of local people employed will increase steadily over time. • The number of jobs created by the DIP is not a justification for the 1,000 houses included in the proposed Dorset Local Plan. • The funding of the DIP is from central government not from Dorset Council Tax. Whilst the money still comes from nationwide tax it is better than it is invested in Dorset rather than elsewhere 	<p>Members of the public and Dorset Councillors</p>

Details of planning applications can be found at https://planning.dorsetcouncil.gov.uk.</p> <p>a) To agree a response to planning application P/FUL/2022/03869 – Land rear of Sunrise and Denton, Dorchester Road, Wool, BH20 6EQ - Erection of a detached bungalow with formation of vehicular access and parking. It was resolved, the following response was agreed: “Overlooking/loss of privacy will still be a problem for existing neighbours and houses; Layout and density of buildings will still be an issue. Highway safety remains an issue. The egress from the site is already precarious and greater traffic density will exacerbate this problem; the flood risk and drainage issues remain exactly the same as they have always been. The problems of access/egress to/from these properties via a very busy main road (already bedevilled by traffic queues caused by the level crossing at peak hours) remain. There is also the problem of safely crossing the road”.</p> <p>b) To agree any other planning applications. No other applications were considered.</p>	Councillors
