Erect extensions and alterations to existing dwelling. It was resolved, the following response was agreed: 'Wool Parish Council has no material planning concerns with this application if planning permission is granted subject to the same Construction Management Plan required by planning application P/FUL/2021/02593 in the interests of road safety. Wool Parish Council would like to make the following points/requests Neighbours' concerns regarding privacy and 'bird strikes' are seriously considered and responded to. There is a concern that the site plan is misleading. The footpath to the south of the site could be misinterpreted as an access road providing vehicular access if a site visit is not carried out. The application is confusing as it appears to conflate applications P/FUL/2021/02593 and P/HOU/2022/02989 in places, particularly where benefits are claimed.'</p> <p>b) To agree a response to planning application P/HOU/2022/02514 - 19 Cologne Road Bovington Wareham BH20 6NS.
